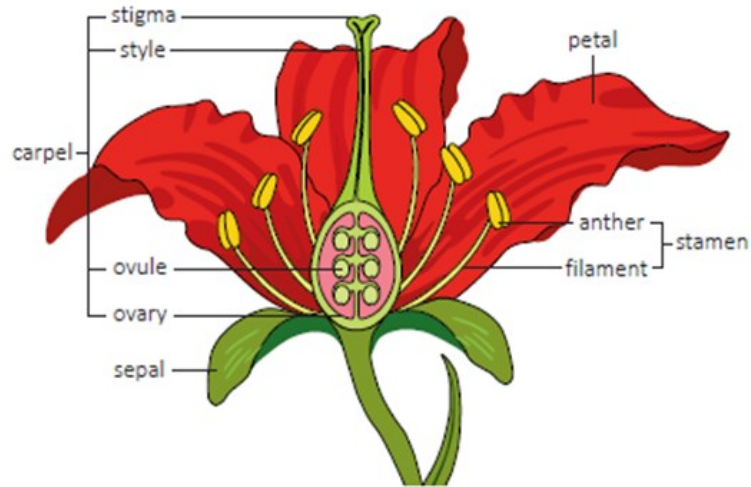


# Y5: 'Living things and their habitats' knowledge organiser

Most plants contain both the **male sex cell (pollen)** and the **female sex cell (ovules)**, but most plants can't **fertilise** themselves. Wind and insects help to transfer the pollen to a different plant. They need two parent plants to produce their offspring.

However, **asexual reproduction** is when a plant reproduces by itself. It only needs one parent plant. The offspring of this are identical to the parent plant.
