A **biome** is a large ecological area on the Earth's surface, such as desert, forest, grassland, tundra and aquatic.

Agricultural land use is divided into three groups **arable**, **pastoral** and **mixed farming**. An **allotment** is a small piece of land used to grow fruit, vegetables and flowers.

A wide variety of crops are farmed in the UK as well as a wide variety of **livestock** that are reared on farms.

Farming challenges for developing countries include poor soil, disease, drought and lack of markets.

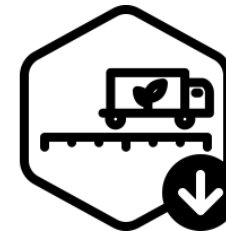
Transport networks help food to be **imported** and **exported** to different countries.
