**(There was a low engagement rate (90 responses) with only 27% of parents completing the survey).**

### Strengths:

- 97% of parents would recommend the school
- 100% of parents agree or strongly agree their child is happy at school
- 99% agree or strongly agree their child feels safe
- 99% agree or strongly agree their child does well at school

### Areas to Note:

- Question 4 (bullying) has 40% N/A responses (likely parents whose children haven't experienced bullying) and 25% "Don't Know" responses
- Question 6 (concerns dealt with properly) has 18% N/A responses, suggesting not all parents have raised concerns
- Among SEND parents (10 responses), 79% agree or strongly agree the school provides adequate support
