

## Year 3 Shepreth Wildlife Park Visit

Wednesday 29th January 2025

Dear parents/ carers,

We are planning to take the children to Shepreth Wildlife Park on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> March. This trip will enhance the children's learning of their science curriculum about animals and bring their project 'Fang and Claw' to life.

The children will need to arrive at school at the normal time of 8:40 am, but please make sure they are on time as the coach cannot wait for late arrivals. To make the most of the day, we will be returning just in time for the children to be picked up at 3pm.

All children will need to wear full school uniform in order for them to be easily identified throughout the trip, but they are invited to wear comfortable shoes for walking. They will need to bring a packed lunch, a snack and sufficient drink in a backpack. If your child receives Free School Meals, please contact the school office who will arrange for their lunch to be delivered early to take with them on the trip. Spending money is not required as we are not visiting the gift shop.

There will be a cost for this trip which covers the coach and entry to the wildlife park. We are asking for a contribution of £22.10 per pupil, and this will need to be paid by Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2025 via Reach More Parents.

This activity cannot be fully funded without these contributions and will be cancelled if necessary. [This is in line with the School Charging Policy, which has been compiled in accordance with Sections 449-462 of the Education Act (1996).]

If it is necessary for your child to be given non-prescribed medication whilst on the trip (e.g. travel sickness medication) arrangements can be made for this by contacting the school office prior to the trip.
