As you are aware, much of our curriculum is interwoven and our learning links to a 'project'. Each year group takes part in four or five projects over the course of the school year.

To facilitate the children retaining their new knowledge from the project, we regularly revisit project content to see what learning the children can retrieve. One of the strategies we use is known as 'Innovation Friday,' where pupils are set a challenge to show what knowledge they have retained from a project studied many weeks, or months, prior.

Our next Innovation Friday is on **Friday 25th April** and Year 4 would like to invite you to join them so you too can see what they can recall from their learning about 'Electricity'. The session will **begin at 2:15pm and will run until 2:45pm** to give the pupils time to clear away before the end of the day.

Before this session, the children will design an electronic game that demonstrates their understanding of electrical circuits. You will have the opportunity to help them finish off their games and then test them out. Their games will be based on improving the recall of their multiplication facts. To facilitate this, we are asking for cardboard/ recycling donations before the day, so the children can create their games.

Should you be able to attend on the afternoon of Friday 25nd April, please arrive at the main school entrance for 2:10pm so that we can sign you in and take you into your child's classroom for the start of the session.
