

## Year 6 Cadbury World Visit

Friday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2025

Dear parents/ carers of year 6 pupils

We are planning to take the children to Cadbury World on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> May. This trip will enhance the children's history learning about the ancient Maya and their discoveries. Luckily for us, this included the cacao bean!

The children will need to arrive at school at no later than 8:40am please; the coach cannot wait for late arrivals. To make the most of the visit and workshops available, we will be returning to school for approximately 4:30pm. We will use the pupils' normal collection arrangements unless you inform us otherwise.

All children will need to wear full school uniform in order for them to be easily identified throughout the trip, but they are invited to wear comfortable shoes for walking. They will need to bring a packed lunch, a snack and sufficient drink in a backpack. If your child receives Free School Meals, please contact the school office who will arrange for their lunch to be delivered early to take with them on the trip.

Children are invited to bring a small amount of spending money (we recommend no more than £5) to purchase a souvenir in the gift shop. This money will need to be in a named purse/ wallet and be kept in their backpack.

There will be a cost for this trip which covers the coach travel and entry to Cadbury World. We are asking for a contribution of **£XXXX** per pupil, and this will need to be paid by **DATE** via **PAYMENT PORTAL** please.
