Dear parents/ carers,

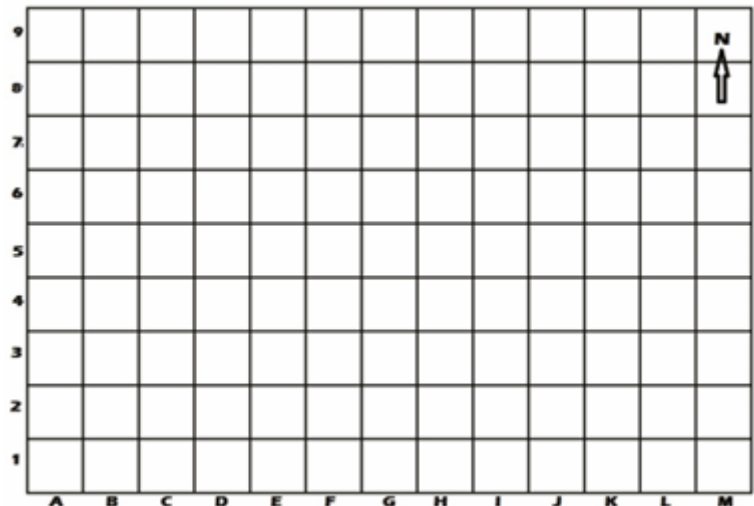
We are excited to invite you to our second session of Family Maths this academic year which will take place on Friday 17th April 2026 2.15-2.50pm. It is a valuable opportunity to come into school and engage in some fun maths activities with your children. Do not worry – you will not be tested nor judged on your maths knowledge!

During the session, you will have the chance to investigate number, explore shapes and use problem-solving to think outside the box! If you have children in different classes, you will be able to join up as a family to complete tasks.

There is an example of an activity below; maybe you could have a go at this one at home?

In the zoo, the animals need **RECTANGULAR** enclosures. (1 square = 1 m²)

1. Make a chicken enclosure which covers an area of 36 m² in the south-west corner of the map. Draw the chickens and make the enclosure yellow.
2. In the centre of the map make a rabbit enclosure that covers 4 m². Draw in the rabbits and colour the enclosure green.
3. In the east of the map make a lamb enclosure which covers 10 m². Draw in the lambs and colour the enclosure light brown.
4. Can you fit in any other enclosures? What area do they have and what animals are kept there? Draw paths to join all your enclosures.
