Dear parents/ carers,

We are planning to take the children to Hunstanton beach and seafront on Wednesday 1st July. This trip will enhance the children's learning in their science topic 'Living things and their Habitats' and bring their project 'The Deep' to life. Whilst at the coast, the children will have the opportunity to explore beach wildlife, create beach art, feel the sand between their toes (and in every nook and cranny!) and take part in our SEJ sand sculpture competition.

The children will need to arrive at school at the normal time of 8.40 am, but please make sure they are on time as we need to leave promptly at 9am. The coach cannot wait for late arrivals. To make the most of the day, we will not be returning to school until 5:30pm.

On the day you will need to bring a packed lunch, a snack and sufficient drink in a backpack. If your child receives Free School Meals, please contact the school office who will arrange for their lunch to be delivered early to take with them on the trip.

Children are invited to bring a small amount of money to purchase an ice cream on the day. This money will need to be in a named purse/ wallet and be kept in their backpack.

There will be a cost for this trip which covers the coach travel to Hunstanton. We are asking for a contribution of £21.00 per pupil, and this will need to be paid by 12th June 2026 via ParentPay please. To help with payment, there is the option to pay for the trip in instalments when you log in.

This activity cannot be fully funded without these contributions and will be cancelled if necessary. [This is in line with the School Charging Policy, which has been compiled in accordance with Sections 449-462 of the Education Act (1996).]

If it is necessary for your child to be given medication whilst on the trip (e.g. travel sickness medication), arrangements can be made for this by contacting the school office prior to the trip.

Further information regarding the trip, including what to wear on the day, will be sent closer to the date.
